After reviewing feedback from around 300 alumni students of the 2019 batch, it is observed that most are satisfied with the overall facilities and support they received during their time at the institution. However, about 8% - 10% of alumni pointed out few areas where they believe improvements could be made for enhancing the overall learning experience.

Key Areas for Improvement Identified:

Skill Development

Students suggested that there should be more emphasis on practical learning and skill development. They felt that integrating hands-on sessions, internships, and real-world projects into the curriculum would better prepare students for the industry.

Communication and Presentation Skills

Some alumni suggested that more steps could be taken to improve students communication skills. They highlighted the importance of both verbal and written communication and recommended conduct of more interactive sessions, presentations, and workshops to help students develop these skills.

Lifelong Learning

A few alumni recommended providing more opportunities for learning beyond the academic curriculum. They suggested setting up platforms or resources to help students pursue self-directed learning, such as workshops, certifications, and online courses.

Leadership Qualities

About 8% of alumni felt that opportunities for developing leadership skills could be improved. They recommended offering more leadership roles in clubs, group projects, student organizations and events, providing students with real-world leadership experiences.

Observations from the student/Exit feedback across all departments:

Based on the exit student feedback on curriculum delivery, teaching-learning processes, and college facilities, the following observations were made:

- Over 90% of students expressed satisfaction with the Program Outcomes (POs) and Program-Specific Outcomes (PSOs). However, 5%-8% reported partial satisfaction or dissatisfaction. Specific areas such as engineering and society (PO6), ethics (PO8), and individual and teamwork (PO9) had partial satisfaction levels of around 6%-7%.
- Around 90%-92% of students were satisfied with the college's teaching and learning environment, though 7%-9% indicated partial satisfaction or dissatisfaction.
- For the facilities and services, 80%-90% of students expressed satisfaction. However, about 15% were dissatisfied with the IIPC (Industry-Institute Partnership Cell) and EDC (Entrepreneurship Development Cell). Additionally, students reported partial satisfaction with canteen facilities, multimedia facilities in classrooms, and the auditorium. Similar feedback was observed for clubs and computers with internet access.





Following are the observations made from the feedback collected:

- 95% of the faculty expressed satisfaction with the content of the course syllabus.
- 10-15% of faculty suggested the need for a better balance between theoretical and practical sessions.
- 97% of faculty acknowledged that the required course materials are readily available in the library. However,
 a few recommended including additional resources for newly introduced courses.
- 95% of faculty stated that the current instructional pattern is effective, as it allows for complete syllabus coverage within the specified timeframe and facilitates timely student assessments aligned with the course objectives.
