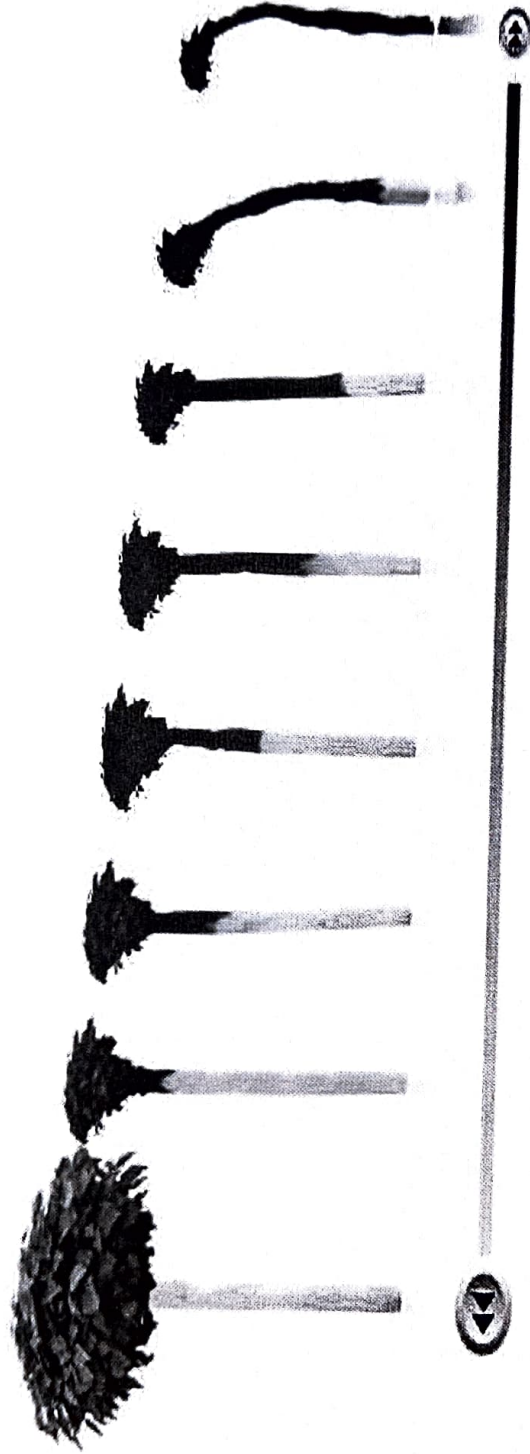

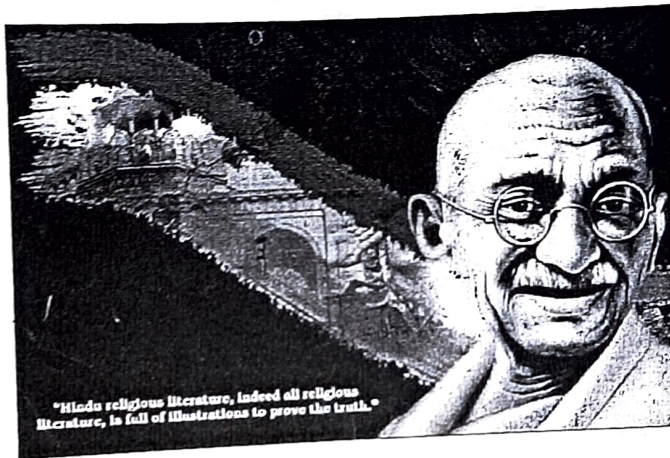

**MAHATMA GANDHI JAYANTHI**

Mahatma Gandhi is known as the Father of the Nation. He played a significant role in the fight against Britishers and helped India gain its independence. He contributed to the freedom struggle of India through his non-violent ways and helped the nation get rid of age-old practices like untouchability too. His philosophy and Nobel work made him gain the title of 'Mahatma' which literally means 'Great Soul'. His ideologies and philosophy made him popular around the world. On June 15, 2007, the United Nations General Assembly passed a resolution to declare October 2 as the International Day of Non-Violence.



Gandhi's passive resistance against the British power and tremendous talent of inspiring and influencing popular figures made him a worldwide figure. He introduced India to the non-cooperation movement, Salt March, Swaraj, and many more non-violent ways to protest against the British rule. He also promoted the idea to get economic freedom through the concept of 'Swadeshi'. 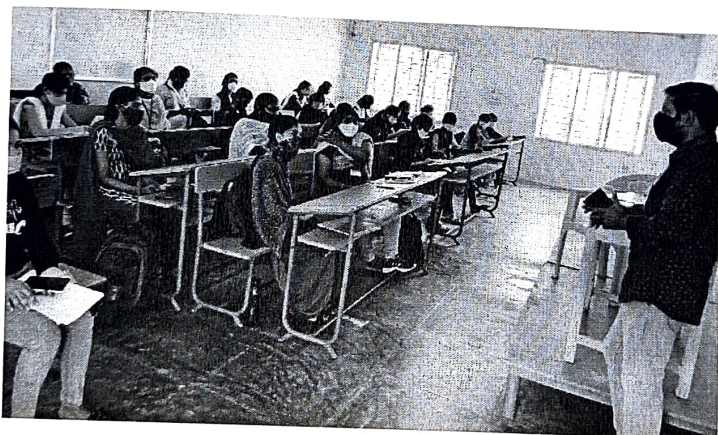

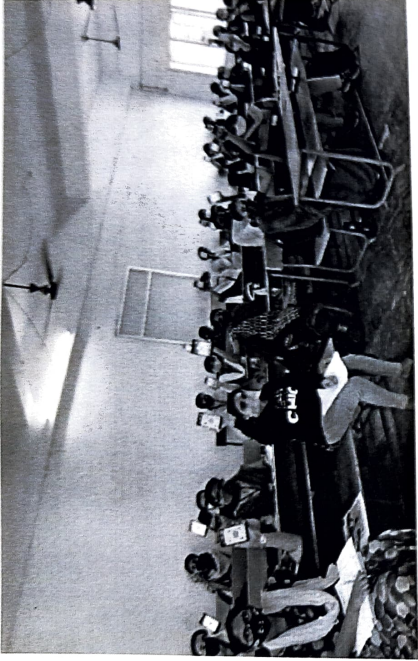


**AWARENESS ON DISHA APP**  
(03/12/2020)

On 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2020, GVP NSS Unit in association with Eenadu News Paper organized an awareness program on DISHA APP. The main features of DISHA APP are outlined below.

**Disha App**, developed by the technical services division of the Andhra Pradesh police, sends an alert to the Disha control room when a woman or girl in distress just shakes the mobile phone which contains the Disha App. The App also provides another way of calling for help - they can also press a button on the phone, but in emergency situations if that is not possible, the victim can send an alert to the police by simply shaking the phone five times. The personnel at Disha control room in turn will alert the police available near the spot. Police will rush to the spot using GPS-equipped vehicles and assist the person in trouble or anticipating trouble.





The Application has latest features such as recording video and audio. The App is helpful in presenting substantive and conclusive evidence with audio/video clips.

The awareness program was attended by students attending the offline classes. The students appreciated the DISHA APP. Eenadu reporter enlightened the students about the App.

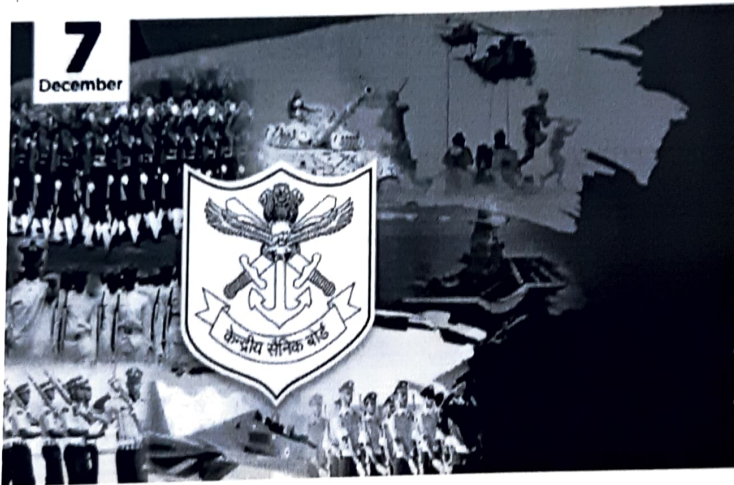
