

- Capture and maintain the performance data related to innovations and provide reports to institutional innovation council (IIC). Contribute to expand the Innovation tool-kit data base.

### II. Entrepreneurship Working Committee:

Responsible for organizing and coordinating after entrepreneurial and Startup promotion activities and extend support to other activities. Participating and executing following activities related to entrepreneurship development at department level:

- Gain knowledge and expertise in startup and entrepreneurship by attending trainings, workshops, conferences, expert talks etc. related to entrepreneurship. Inspire and encourage students also to do the same.

- 7. Offer access to pre-incubation facility to students, staff and faculty for mutually acceptable time-frame for doing activities related to pre-incubation.
- 8. Periodic impact assessment of institute's pre-incubation activities using defined evaluation parameters and report the same to IIC.

### IV. Incubation Working Committee:

Incubation is a unique and highly flexible combination of business development processes, infrastructure and people, designed to nurture and grow new and small businesses by supporting them through the early stages of development.

- 1. Provide inputs on building a state of the art incubation facility at institute and support the IIC in related activities.
- Play an expert role in startup creation after applying suitable processes to startup selection/admission. Provide access to finance; provide administrative support; provide startup education and access to knowledge.
- 3. Provide assistance in early stage development of startup like mentoring & coaching, advisory services, networking, technology transfer, assistance with business basics and marketing, HR training etc.
- 4. Provide in assistance in defining exit strategy for startup expansion

#### REPORT ON

#### ONE DAY WORKSHOP "PCB DESIGNING AND FABRICATION"

Aiming to provide an intense training on designing and fabricating a Printed Circuit Board (PCB) at undergraduate level, a one-day workshop on "PCB DESIGN AND FABRICATION" held on 24-08-2019 at GVP COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING FOR WOMEN. The inauguration of the event was started in the presence of Prof.G.Sudheer, vice principle, Mr.V.V.S.Satyanarayana, Assistant Professor, Ms.P.Sridevi, Assistant Professor and IEEE members at 10:00AM. The session ended after discussing about the importance of PCB.

At 11:00AM the lecture was started, with types of PCB and usage of the software called eagle where an electronic circuit is designed. After the completion of brief lecture all the members were divided into groups and projects of individual interest were assigned then the groups started drawing the circuits in eagle and the blueprints were made.

In the Afternoon Sessionthe procedure to print the designed circuit using Eagle software is discussed and executed as follows:

- 1) Taken a print of the circuit on a glossy paper and a piece of copper clad. The copper clad is cut according to the size of the circuit.
- 2) Then overlapthe copper clad and the printed circuit which was on the glossy paper and ironed it for 5 minutes by applying a lot of weight on it. After this the circuit gets printed on to the copper clad.
- 3) Then the process of etching is done, in this process the printed circuit board is dip in ferric chloride solution until the naked copper is removed.
- 4) Then holes are made in the circuit board with the help of a mini drill, and connected the components.
- 5) Finally, testing of the circuit was done and the corresponding outputs were noted down.
