#### NSS UNIT SURVEY REPORT ON DOOR-TO-DOOR VISIT AT SAMBHUVANIPALEM

DATE: 10-12-2019

#### DAY-1

All the members of the NSS unit had one-to-one interaction with the people of the village. Nearly 60 households were covered during the survey. The residents of the village were enquired about the basic facilities and provisions like water, electricity, roads and schools to which we got a positive response. However, a series of problems faced by the residents of the village came into light after the interaction.

#### TRANSPORT

- Poor transportation facilities are causing hindrance to their daily activities and also during emergency situations.
- 2. Only two autos are available to connect the village with the city due to which they have to pay higher charges during emergencies.
- 3. The route to the village is also not commutable for heavy vehicles.

#### MEDICAL FACILITIES

- No hospital or dispensary is at reach of the village people. Instead they have to move to the city for even basic first aid.
- 2. No medical stores are available within the reach of the people.
- 3. No RMP doctors have visited the village so far.
- 4. More medical health check-up camps were requested by the people.
- 5. The local compounder does not respond effectively to the people's necessities.
- 6. Most of the people complaint about breeding of mosquitoes.
- 7. No proper treatments for skin allergies.
- 8. The stray dogs in the village are suffering from various skin diseases.

#### EDUCATION

- 1. No scope for higher education in the village.
- Only primary schooling upto standard 5<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. The dropout rate at high school level is very high comparatively.

- 5. Only two teachers are available to teach the children from standard 1 to 5.
- 6. Most of the families send their children to the city to pursue higher education.

- 1. Most of the people dump their wastes in the backyards or drainage sewers.
- Only one GVMC garbage collector is available to manage the wastes of all the households.
- 3. Provisions must be provided to the garbage collector.

#### SANITATION

- 1. Most of the households have basic sanitation facilities.
- 2. Most of the women prefer traditional sanitation measures.
- 3. Some of the households still lack proper toilets.

#### BASIC AMENITIES

- 1. No general stores.
- No ration distribution centers.
- 3. Most of the people do not have Aarogyasri Health Cards.
- 4. Few families do not possess Ration Cards.
- No vegetable or fruit markets in the village.
- 6. No banks or self help centers or groups.
- 7. 24\*7 electricity supply.
- 8. Most of the streets are well lit.
- 9. No network coverage in the village area.
- 10. Aanganwaadi Safe house is located in the starting of the village.
- 11. Women safety is well taken care of.






#### DAY-4






