Cognitive Radio Spectrum Sensing Detection Methods using Matlab Simulink

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Abstract—Cognitive radio networks provide an opportunity for unlicensed users (secondary users) to use the allocated spectrum band when not in use by legitimate users (primary users). To use a channel or spectrum, it is required to sense the channel for the presence of primary user which is called Spectrum Sensing. In order to reduce the sensing time of spectrum and to determine the state of the channel whether it is free or not in advance, spectrum prediction techniques can be used. In this paper, different techniques and learning models that can be applied to predict the state of spectrum band for the presence of primary user are discussed.

Keywords—Cognitive Radio Networks, spectrum prediction, channel state prediction, activity modelling.

I. INTRODUCTION

With the increase in number of users, the need of spectrum has also increased significantly. However, the spectrum band or bandwidth available for the communication is limited. Federal Communications Commission (FCC) in US is one of the main central authorities that allocate and regulate the spectrum bandwidth. The FCC frequency chart shows the spectrum allocated over all the frequency bands. This chart explains the spectrum scarcity especially for the band under 3GHz. On the contrary, actual measurements that were taken in downtown Berkeley as shown in figure a distinctive utilization of 0.5% in 3-4 GHz frequency band which further drops to 0.3% in the 4-5 GHz band. This suggests that the spectrum available for communication is mostly allocated but it is often used inefficiently. To deal with the problem of spectrum scarcity and inefficient spectrum usage, FCC has permitted the unlicensed users to use the spectrum in the absence of licensed users. This provides a way to various technologies such as dynamic spectrum access, cognitive radio networks, software defined radios etc. Cognitive Radio Networks can be primarily used for this purpose due to their ability to adapt to networks conditions. A cognitive network is a network with a cognitive process that can perceive current network conditions, and then plan, decide, and act according to those conditions. The network can learn from these adaptations and use them to make its future decisions, while taking into account the end-to-end goals". Cognitive radio networks enables the unlicensed users often termed as secondary users to use the available channel bandwidth in the absence of licensed user or primary user. Since secondary users can use the spectrum band only in the absence of primary user, on the appearance of primary user appears they have to evacuate the band immediately. Thus to use a spectrum band, secondary users have a limited time period in which it has to select the appropriate band, transfer the data and evacuate the band. The major spectrum management functions are: spectrum sensing, spectrum decision, spectrum sharing and spectrum mobility.




Fig. 1. Measurement of Spectrum utilization at BWRC




Fig. 2. Trade-off between Spectrum Sensing Time and Access Time

In order to use the available bandwidth, secondary users have to sense the spectrum for the presence of primary user, so that CR users or secondary users can dynamically use the available bandwidth. But the bandwidth is available only for a limited time period. Thus to save the spectrum sensing time and increase the efficiency of spectrum utilization, spectrum prediction or channel state prediction techniques can be used. By using channel state prediction techniques, CR user can skip sensing those channels which are predicted to be busy, hence saving the sensing time as well as energy. Figure 2 shows the tradeoff between spectrum sensing time and spectrum access time. Spectrum prediction techniques can also be used to determine the quality of service provided by the channel. A number of techniques have been introduced over a period of time to predict the channel state. Considerable amount of research is going on in this direction to provide more accurate predictions. In this paper, we discuss different methods and the research that has been done so far on the techniques that have been used for the channel state prediction.

A Brief on “Brain Fingerprinting Technology”

Abstract—Brain Fingerprinting is a new computer-based technology to identify the perpetrator of a crime accurately and scientifically by measuring brain-wave responses to crime-relevant words or pictures on a computer screen. Brain fingerprinting is based on finding that the brain generates a unique brain wave pattern when a person encounters a familiar stimulus.

Keywords: *Brain fingerprinting, Unique brain wave pattern, magnetic resonance.*

I. INTRODUCTION

In the field of criminology, a new lie detector has been developed in the United States of America. This is called “brain fingerprinting”. This invention is supposed to be the best lie detector available as on date and is said to detect even smooth criminals who pass the polygraph test (the conventional lie detector test) with ease. The new method employs brain waves, which are useful in detecting whether the person subjected to the test, remembers finer details of the crime. Even if the person willingly suppresses the necessary information, the brain wave is sure to trap him, according to the experts, who are very excited about the new kid on the block. Brain Fingerprinting is a controversial proposed investigative technique that measures recognition of familiar stimuli by measuring electrical brain wave responses to words, phrases, or pictures that are presented on computer screen. Brain fingerprinting was invented by Lawrence Farwell.

II. BRAIN FINGERPRINTING

Brain Fingerprinting is based on the principle that the brain is central to all human acts. In a criminal act, there may or may not be many kinds of peripheral evidence, but the brain is always there, planning, executing, and recording the crime. The fundamental difference between a perpetrator and a falsely accused, innocent person is that the perpetrator, having committed the crime, has the details of the crime

stored in his brain, and the innocent suspect does not. This is what Brain Fingerprinting detects scientifically. Brain fingerprinting is a controversial technique that is advocated as a way to identify a terrorist or other dangerous person by measuring the “brain print” of that person when shown a particular body of writing or an image that was previously familiar (such as of a training camp or manual). The brain print is based on the P300 complex, a series of well-known brainwave components that can be measured. The technique is said to be more effective than a lie detector test. Brain fingerprinting is based on finding that the brain generates a unique brain wave pattern when a person encounters a familiar stimulus. Use of functional magnetic resonance imaging in lie detection derives from studies suggesting that persons asked to lie show different patterns of brain activity than they do when being truthful. Issues related to the use of such evidence in courts are discussed.

III. TECHNIQUE

When a crime is committed, a record is stored in the brain of the perpetrator. Brain Fingerprinting provides a means to objectively and scientifically connect evidence from the crime scene with evidence stored in the brain. (This is similar to the process of connecting DNA samples from the perpetrator with biological evidence found at the scene of the crime; only the evidence evaluated by Brain Fingerprinting is evidence stored in the brain.) Brain Fingerprinting measures electrical brain activity in response to crime-relevant words or pictures presented on a computer screen, and reveals a brain MERMER (memory and encoding related multifaceted electroencephalographic response) when, and only when, the evidence stored in the brain matches the evidence from the crime scene. Thus, the guilty can be identified and the innocent can be cleared in an accurate, scientific, objective, non-invasive, non-stressful, and non-testimonial manner.

On the eve of birthday anniversary celebrations of Sri Srinivasa Ramanujan Mathematical Sciences Club conducted several events.

The following are the events conducted

1. Power Point Presentations on Application of Mathematics on 19-12-2019 (for all B. Tech pursuing students) in the areas of
(a) Biology (b) Medicine (c) Engineering (d) Technology
2. Model GATE Mathematics Exam on 20-12-2019 (for 3rd and 4th B. Tech Students) in the syllabus GATE- 2020, Engineering Mathematics.
3. Birth Anniversary Celebrations of Sri Srinivasa Ramanujan on 21st December 2019.

Students actively participated in PPT on the application Mathematics, Prof. K.V.S Rao, Principal, GVPCEW, Dr. K.L.Sai Prasad acted as Judges to the Power Point Presentations made by the students.

A Mock GATE exam based on the Mathematics syllabus given for GATE 2020 was conducted. 110 students have attempted the exam.

On 21st December 2019, celebrations were held in the auditorium, Prof. Dr. M. Phani Krishna Kishore, Professor, Information Technology, GVP College of Engineering (A) delivered a invited talk on the Mathematical Applications to Computer Science and Information Technology.

In the lecture, the speaker advised all the students to get inspired by the great personality of Srinivasa Ramanujan for his passion and love towards Mathematics which led to many discoveries. He also felt that to achieve success in any field one should enjoy learning. He then elaborated the contribution of Ramanujan in the field of Mathematics. His lecture was mainly concentrated on Applications of the mathematical concepts that were included in the curriculum of B.Tech courses. He explained how the Golden ratio inspired Structural

engineers, Biologists, artists, musicians, historians, psychologists. He mentioned the contributions of Codd to Computer Science by the invention of relational model for database management and explained how the relational algebra was used to develop the theory. The speaker elucidated the importance of Page Rank (PR) algorithm used by Google Search to rank websites in their search engine results by counting the number of quality of links to a page to determine a rough estimate of the importance of a website. He also stressed upon the importance of Fourier series and Transforms in Signal Processing and Image Processing. He elucidated how the Fast Fourier Transforms (FFT) are used in processing of digital signals and conversion of time domain to frequency domain.

Finally, he concluded by mentioning the importance of the Number Theory in Cryptography and the remarkable discoveries of Sri Srinivasa Ramanujan in this field. Students appreciated the importance of Discrete Mathematics in the foundation for Programming and Computer Science. All the students are excited by his lecture. At the end of the program prizes were distributed to the winners in the various events conducted.
