The awareness program was attended by students attending the offline classes. The students appreciated the DISHA APP. Eenadu reporter enlightened the students about the App.



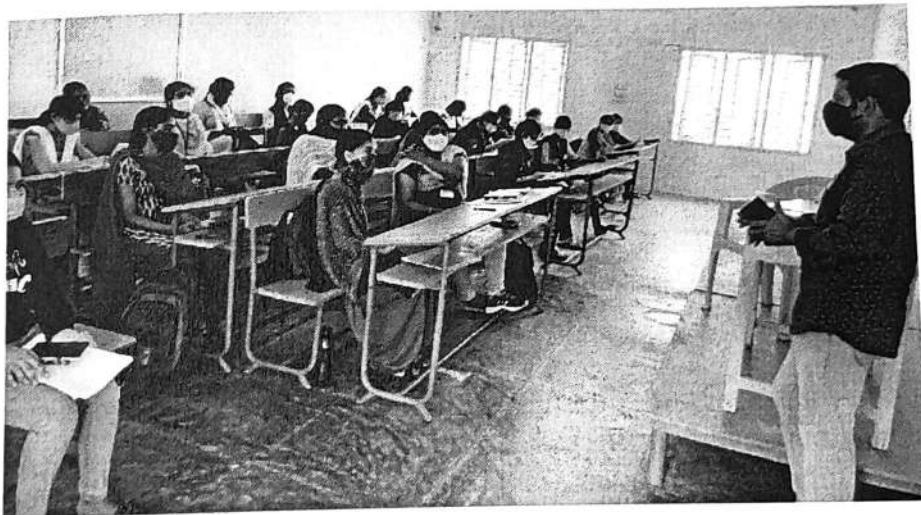

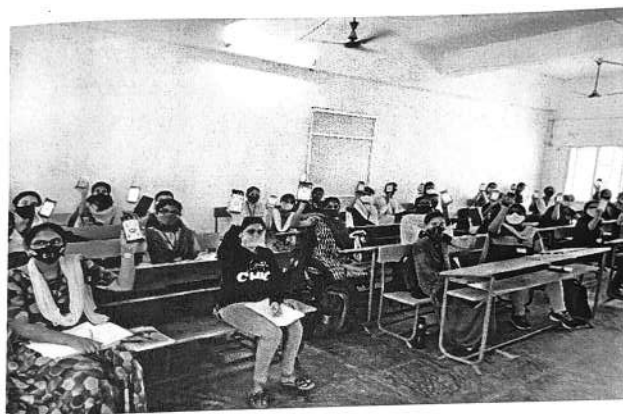
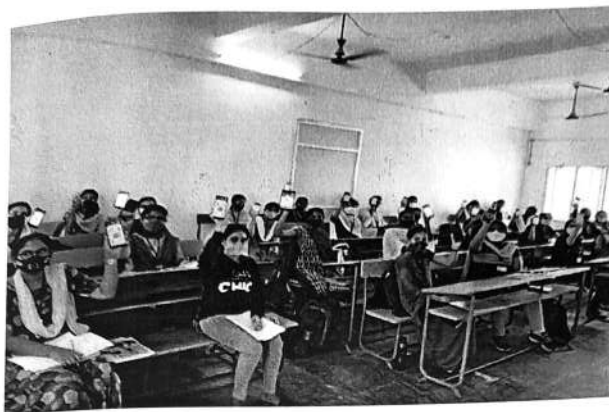

Eligibility:

- The candidate should have registered for the National Women's Parliament.
- The candidate must be a bona fide student of a Full Time College at the time of this

How to apply?

1. Send us CD or DVD of your speech via courier along with your NWP registration number. You can also email your media clip on ir@nationalwomensparliament.org and mention your NWP registration number.
2. Please mention topic of speech on the CD / DVD or email subject.
3. The medium of expression will be English / Telugu for any of the above 5 topics.
4. Speech can be video recorded on any device. E.g. Smartphone, Digital Camera, Video Camera etc.
5. You are allowed to send entries on multiple subject however your selection is likely to be for one topic only.

Duration of Speech: Not to exceed 03 minutes.

Last Date for Submission of Speech:

The Student Speaker is supposed to send her recorded speech by January 27th, 2017.

Selection Process:

1. The Selection Panel will scrutinize all speeches after January 27, 2017.
2. The panel will select the speakers based on the 5 laid down criterion namely Communication skills, Credibility and relevance of Content as per the Topic, Presentation ability, Confidence in Public Speaking and Command over language.
3. The shortlisted candidates will be personally informed by the NWP committee on their registered email id.
4. Final selection / audition test of short listed candidates will be conducted at Amaravati, one day prior from 9:30 am onwards.
